**Otto Rost had to leave early and wishes to complete his information session*

According to Otto, this weekend is the last opportunity to treat for varroa with oxalic acid.

He believes that this information may be useful to those beekeepers that have not packed their hives yet, did not treat for varroa in the fall or treated early.

Treatment at this time will give their colonies a better chance of survival.

***STORING HONEY FRAMES*

A perfect place is cool and dry, dark (moths do not like the dark) and ventilated to protect them from wax moth and other pests . You can store them in a fridge or freezer, in a root cellar or outside in an unheated shed.
